

Interactive Sessions



City tour to Rourkela



It is a reknowned TMT manufacturer in Odisha.With the help of the Management Department head of IIPM ,Rourkela; the students of St Xavier's College, Mahuadanr got an opportunity to visit the production site at Scan Steels Limited . The authorities of the industry took a brief session of the students where they explained their operating activity and marketing process. The raw material used here is iron ore, coal, and a small amount of dolomite. They are mixed in required proportion. It gets a heat treatment, where iron ore is converted into molten iron and through a continuous process of heating and cooling at requisite temperature, sponge iron is obtained. It is further exposed to heat and pressed into rectangular bars from which TMT rods are manufactured. It was an enriching visit and towards the end, the students had a question answer session in which they clarified their doubts. Also they were supplemented with refreshments .



Cultural Programme on International day of Dance



on

Process of Making Ice-Cream



Introduction

Ice-Cream is an antidote against the blistering summer heat. Ice cream is made from a blend of dairy products (cream, condensed milk, and butterfat), sugar, flavorings, and federally approved additives. Eggs are added for some flavorings. The broad guidelines allow producers to use ingredients ranging from sweet cream to nonfat dry milk, cane sugar to corn-syrup solids, fresh eggs to powdered eggs. The additives, which act as emulsifiers and stabilizers, are used to prevent heat shock and the formation of ice crystals during the production process. Ice cream flavors have come a long way from the standard vanilla, strawberry, and chocolate. In an ever-expanding array of combinations, fruit purees and extracts, cocoa powder, nuts, cookie pieces, and cookie dough are blended into the ice cream. The students of the Department of Physics were taken for a field study to Maharaja Ice cream factory.

Value of study Tour

Study tours are essential for the overall development of a student. They provide valuable educational opportunities away from the classroom without using textbooks. The Study tour provides practical exposure to the students where they could experience the process of making of ice cream.

Objectives:

To know the process of making the ice-cream

e. Add Liquid Flavors and Colors

Liquid flavors and colors may be added to the mix before freezing. Only ingredients that are liquid can be added before the freezing, to make sure the mix flows properly through the freezing equipment.

f. Freeze

The process involves freezing the mix and incorporating air. Ice cream mix can be frozen in batch or continuous freezers and the conditions used will depend on the type of freezer. Batch freezers consist of a rotating barrel that is usually filled one-third to one-half full with ice cream mix. As the barrel turns, the air in the barrel is incorporated into the ice cream mix. Ice cream freezers designed for home use are batch freezers. Continuous freezers consist of a fixed barrel that has a blade inside that constantly scrapes the surface of freezing barrel. The ice cream mix is pumped from a bulk tank to the freezing barrel and the air is incorporated with another pump just before it enters the freezing barrel. The continuous freezing process is much faster than the batch freezing process.

The addition of air is called overrun and contributes to the lightness or denseness of ice cream. Up to 50% of the volume of the finished ice cream (100% overrun) can be air that is incorporated during freezing. At the point of discharge from the freezer (draw temperature), only about 50% of the water in ice cream is frozen. Soft serve ice cream is generated at this point in the freezing process.

g. Add Fruits, Nuts and Bulky Flavorings (candy pieces, etc.)

Fruits, swirls, and any bulky type of flavorings (nuts, candy pieces, etc.) are added at this point. These ingredients cannot be added before freezing or they would interfere with the smooth flow of the mix through the freezer. The ice cream at this point is soft and it is easy to mix in the bulky flavorings so they are uniformly distributed throughout the ice cream. Mixing in bulky flavorings after freezing also prevents damage to the pieces and allows them to remain whole or in large chunks.


8. Package

As desired, depending on the product it is packed into cups, cones or paper mould.

9. Harden

The ice cream is cooled as quickly as possible down to a holding temperature of less than $-13^{\circ}F(-25^{\circ}C)$. The temperatures and times of cooling will depend on the type of storage freezer. Rapid cooling will promote quick freezing of water and create small ice crystals. Storage at $-13^{\circ}F(-25^{\circ}C)$ will help to stabilize the ice crystals and maintain product quality. At this temperature there is still a small portion of liquid water. If all the water present in the ice cream were frozen, the ice cream would be as hard as an ice cube.





Findings & Outcomes:

The students appreciated the effort of the officials to run a factory in the remote area as Mahuadanr despite the non-availability of continuous power supply. As Ice-Cream is an antidote to beat the blistering summer heat, people welcome it. The various process involved and the ingredients used enlightened the students to have greater love for Physics. The use of emulsifiers and stabilizers and the addition of air in the process made the whole process much beneficial. There is large supply of ice creams from Maharaja company in the town. The demand for ice cream is overwhelming on market days (Monday, Thursday). The ice cream company provides employment opportunity for many youth.

Conclusion:

The field trip helped the students to appreciate the discipline of their choice because of the vast application of it in the daily living. The students could analyze the various principles involved in the production of ice cream. The students were inspired to plan about their future to begin startups using the principles of physics. The great learning enabled them to return with great self-confidence and determination








MUSHROOM CULTIVATION



Introduction:

Mushroom has been used as food and medicine from ancient times. Mushroom contains all essential amino acids, vitamin B complex, iron, calcium, potassium, phosphorus, folic acid and other biochemical compounds. It is also a good source of dietary fibre. It is recommended even for people suffering from cholesterol problems, heart diseases, diabetes and cancer. Mushroom cultivation has now become income generating, since there is great demand for healthy and quality food products. Mushroom cultivation involves small initial investment; but the production is year-round. It is an eco-friendly agricultural practice. Considering the commercial viability and self- employment potential of mushroom cultivation and marketing, the Department of Botany conducted filed visit study for the students.

Value of study Tour:

Mushroom cultivation is fast yielding and it has high market demand and nutrition value. Being a reliable source of income, it is particularly beneficial to the poor. It is attractive to rural and urban farmers since mushroom cultivation does not require land.

Objectives:

To know the nutrient values of mushrooms.

- To enable the students to identify the edible and poisonous mushrooms
- To provide hands-on training for the preparation of bed for mushroom cultivation and its harvesting, pests and diseases control and post harvesting management.
- To provide the students awareness about the marketing trends of Mushrooms.
- To give the students exposure to the experiences of experts in the field and to functioning mushroom farms.
- To help the students to learn a means of self-employment and income generation

Report:

On 8th and 9th April 2022, the students of Botany, under the supervision of the Faculty of Botany Dept. St. Xavier's College, Mahuadanr, visited Oyster Mushroom Cultivation & Training centre, for a two-day hands-on training programme. It is about 5 km from the college, located at Mahuadanr Block, Latehar district, Jharkhand, India. The students were given detailed input on mushroom cultivation and its nutritional importance in the present scenario. The commercial aspects of mushroom cultivation were also explained. They visited the various plant resources in the campus, which are used in various research related activities. The students were overwhelmed by the knowledge given by a member of this group and by the detailed information provided on mushroom cultivation.

Cultivation of Oyster mushroom:

Production of oyster mushroom can be divided into the following stages:

- a. Selection of raw materials for substrate, for mushroom cultivation: That may be cellulose waste or straw.
- **b.** Chopping and wetting of raw materials for substrate: This increases the density of the substrate, and moisture by 65-70%.

The contrasting requirements of protection from excessive ultraviolet radiation and receiving sufficient sunlight to promote the production of vitamin D by the skin have meant that those inhabiting low latitudes, with high UVR intensity, have darker skin pigmentation for protection from the deleterious effects of UVR, while those in higher latitudes have developed fair skin to maximize vitamin D production from much lower ambient ultraviolet radiation.

In the last few hundred years however, there has been more rapid human migration out of the areas in which we evolved, to all other part of the world. No longer is our skin pigmentation necessarily suited to the environment in which we live. While dark skinned population at low latitudes have very low level of melanoma and cancers of the skin, migration of these people to areas of high latitude has been increase in the incidence of rickets.

Meanwhile, our industrialized society has produced chlorofluorocarbon (CFS) that reacts chemically with the stratospheric ozone that has shielded Earth from most of the harmful wavelength of ultraviolet radiation. The resulting loss of stratospheric ozone has been associated with increasing levels of some types of ultraviolet radiation reaching the Earth's surface. It is difficult to assess changes in UVR due to stratospheric ozone depletion, using ground-based measurement, due to UVR changes associated with fluctuation in cloud cover and increase in lower atmospheric pollution.

Ultraviolet radiation is ubiquitous. Almost everyone has some exposure to ultraviolet radiation on a daily basis. It is an exposure we cannot entirely avoid and, anyway, to strive for zero exposure would create a huge burden of skeletal disease from vitamin D deficiency, However, evaluation of the burden of disease create by excess exposure to UVR is very important since avoidance of excess exposure is a relatively simple public health message.

Instrument are needed that can integrate incident UVR from 200 to 320 nm according to the "effectiveness action spectrum" for skin and eye proposed in order to enforce the proposed standard for occupation exposure do not exist at present.

Accurate and continuous measurement of line UVR reaching the earth from the sun and sky (direct and global) is necessary to



5. **Objective of the Program:**

The purpose of the field visit was to introduce the students of the Department of Botany, St. Xavier's College, Mahuadanr to the diverse flora and ecological aspects of the region and to explore the knowledge of plants with medicinal properties.

6. Detail description of the event:

The field visit was organized as a part of the B.Sc. curriculum, allowing students to experience the practical application of theoretical concepts in botany. The trip commenced on February 18 & 19, 2019 and the students arrived at the Botanical Garden Pakripath. The garden, marked with Latin scientific names for each species, facilitated easy identification and learning. The students observed various plants in their natural habitats, including a cactus garden, gymnosperms, and exotic varieties of bamboos and angiosperms. Soil samples were collected under the supervision of teachers for subsequent analysis in the laboratory. Additionally, plants were collected for herbarium preparation, and local people were consulted to identify medicinal plants and gather information on their traditional uses.

During the visit, the students identified several medicinal plants, including Amomum aromaticum, Azadirachta indica, Andrographis paniculata, Catharanthus roseus, Aloe vera, and Phyllantus amarus. The garden also featured shrubs such as Acalypha hispida, Nerium oleander, and various species of Ixora. Floral species like Ixora chinensis, Gardenia jasminoides, Mussaenda erythrophylla, Vinca rosea, and Rosa indica were also observed. The students interacted with the gardeners, who provided insights into plant care and the basic requirements for their growth. The visit enabled the students to learn about different plant types, families, and their varied functions. Many of the plants observed were traditionally used to treat ailments like dysentery, diarrhea, epilepsy, cough, and cold. Some plants, such as Shorea robusta, Tectona

grandis, Sapindus mukorossi, Azadirachta indica, Piper longum, Asparagus racemosus, and Amomum aromaticum, have a long history of traditional usage.

7. Outcome of the event:

The field visit to the Botanical Garden Pakripath proved to be an enriching experience for the students of the Department of Botany, St. Xavier's College, Mahuadanr. The first-hand observation of plants and the practical application of theoretical concepts provided a lasting understanding of the subject. The visit successfully fostered scientific aptitude among the students and deepened their knowledge of plant sciences.

5. Detail description of the event: A field trip to the handloom centre located at Mahuadanr, was carried out by the History department on headed by Asst. Prof. Ravi Roshan Minj and Asst. Prof. Sanjay Bara accompanied by students of B.A Semester II. The centre was visited during the afternoon time around 1:00 p.m and it proved to be a great learning experience for the faculty and students and a change from the routine classes. Due to the active participation, interaction and communication with the people at the handloom centre, it was a source of great information and knowledge about the working ,the product and the activities carried out over there. In the following pages we would give light to all the important facts that we came to know Main highlights

of the working process at the handloom centre

- It takes 14 to 15 days to complete the process making of a piece of cloth.
- They gain only Rs 55 on the manufacture of per cloth.
- It takes an hour to weave a cloth from the thread.
- There are 6 people engaged on the machine where cloth is weaved from the thread.
- There are six machines and six workers to work on them.
- They provide quality clothes at lower rates.
- The workers earn 10000 to 12000 Rs per month.
- The material for manufacture of cloth is transported here from Kolkata via Ranchi.
- They sell these clothes locally and also transport it to Ranchi and other nearby towns.
- The main attractions manufactured here are sarees, shawls, bandis, towels, kurtis, etc which are available at much lower rates than available in the markets.
- They initially started off as a training centre five to six years back, but with time it has emerged as an independent trading unit .
- Their area of operation extends to five dismils i.e 2178 sq. feet.

The main process of cloth making

This is a small scale handloom centre manufacturing khadi clothes from threads . It involves many procedures before the final cloth is ready to be sent to market or put to sale .

Firstly, the threads in the form of big bundles are converted into fine threads by using spinning wheel –charkha, which is then stored in the form of small bundles of fine threads.

Secondly, these threads are put into a wooden frame from where it is put into the cylindrical wood log of the main machine.

Thirdly, when the threads are systematically put in the main machine, the workers weave clothes from these threads. They introduce different patterns and dyes to make the clothes decorative and attractive.

Finally, they display these clothes and send them to different markets for sale purpose and earn nominal profits over it.

Conclusion and inferences

It is a fast growing entrepreneurship business started almost five years ago. The owners Mr. Merajul Ansari and Mrs Safeela Ansari first started it as a training ground but have expanded their business over the years creating employment for 11-12 people over here and others involved in transportation, trading and sale of the product, locally and also in other towns and cities. Their shawls and bandis have a wide market and they receive orders from other states even. They have been continuously working on its expansion and diversification.

The students response ,interaction and participation also made it an effective field trip . The people at the handloom centre welcomed the professors by making them wear the *bandis and shawls* as a mark of their visit to the handloom centre . It was an overall productive trip to be remembered and learned from . The efforts of the people working at the centre was worth appreciation .


